

WHEN YOUR CHILD IS PLACED OUTSIDE THE HOME

All parents are responsible for their child's costs

You are responsible for your child's costs

All parents are responsible for their child's costs, regardless of whether they live with the child or are his/her guardian.

When a child is placed by the social services in a family home, care home or residential care home (HVB) or assisted living facility, as parent you are liable to pay a contribution to the municipality. The rule applies regardless of the reason why the child has been placed outside the home, and until the child is 18 years old.

How much do I have to pay?

The size of the contribution is based on your latest taxed income and how many minors you are responsible for. Maximum level for the contribution is the same as maintenance support. If you have no income, or it is very low, the contribution can be zero kronor.

You need to provide details of your income so that the social services can calculate the contribution.
